RULES FOR PLAYERS AND PARENTS

Your child has to be registered to be a member of the Junior Cricket.

As a member of Junior Cricket you are expected to abide by the general rules and Code of Conduct for Players and Parents.

All members must play cricket within the Laws and in the Spirit of the game.

All members must respect colleagues, opponents and officials. Do not make derogatory comments or gestures about your colleagues or opponents. Never try to intimidate the opposition by threats or excessive triumphal.

All members should be polite to coaches/umpires and respect their decisions. Do not show dissent! Do not throw tantrums. Such behaviour invites sanctions such as disqualification from training and matches.

All members should not interfere with coaches where management and selection of team is concerned. If members have any queries they should take their case to the head coach.

All members should keep to agreed timings for practice and matches or inform their coach at the earliest possible opportunity if they cannot play or are going to be late.

All members must wear the appropriate kit properly! Cricket whites and suitable trainers or cricket shoes should be worn for matches but tracksuits are permitted for practicing.

All players under must wear helmets when batting and when standing up to the stumps when wicket keeping.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

The Code of Conduct at matches is as follows:

It is the captain's responsibility to ensure that his player's behaviour is within the spirit of cricket at all times. The spirit of the game involves respect for:

- Your opponents
- Your own captain and team
- The umpires and the role of the umpires
- The games traditional values

It is against the Spirit of the Game:

To dispute decisions made by an umpire, coach, manager or others by word, gesture or action either on or off the field of play.

To seek to distract an opponent/coach/umpire either verbally or by harassment with persistent clapping or unnecessary noise under the guise of enthusiasm and motivation of one's own side

To use abusive language on or off the field

To appeal excessively when there is no chance of a batsman being out.

To neglect school/academic studies and homework for cricket.

To expect to be selected only on talent. Other criterion includes:

- 1) Thai Nationals
- 2) Permanent Residence in Thailand
- 3) Minimum of 5 years stay in Thailand
- 4) Discipline on and off the field
- 5) Good attitude on and off the field
- 6) Respect for peers and coaches on and off the field

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/SPECTATORS

It has obviously been felt necessary to publish a Code of Conduct for parents

Youth cricket depends upon the active support of the parent body - indeed it would not exist without it.

This code applies to all junior matches, coaching sessions and all other events that fall under the jurisdiction of Junior Cricket.

1. Remember that children play cricket for their enjoyment, not yours.
2. Encourage children to participate do not force them.
3. Focus on the child's effort and performance rather than winning, losing or selection for League Matches
4. Encourage children to learn the Laws of the Game and to play within the Spirit of those Laws.
5. Set a good example by recognising fair play and by applauding the good performances of all.
6. Encourage children to participate according to the rules.
7. Support all effort to remove verbal abuse/unfair play and disputes from cricket by either child or parent.
8. Respect coach decisions and teach your child to do likewise.
9. Parent interference with training, coaching and League Match selection is forbidden.
10. Respect the need for additional payment of the quoted amount by the manager for facilities and transport should your child be selected to play for League Matches.
